- 3 "Sec. 501. (*Effective July 1, 2004*) The Secretary of the Office of Policy
4 and Management shall make a grant of seventy-five thousand dollars
5 to each municipality, over a six-year period, for the purpose of revising
6 and updating local zoning regulations and plans of conservation and
7 development in accordance with the provisions of section 8-23 of the
8 general statutes, as amended by this act, subsection (a) of section 8-2 of
9 the general statutes, as amended by this act, and section 8-25 of the
10 general statutes, as amended by this act."
