**"AN ACT CONCERNING FUNERAL DIRECTORS AND VITAL RECORDS."**

1 After the last section, add the following and renumber sections and  
2 internal references accordingly:

3 "Sec. 501. Section 7-48a of the general statutes is repealed and the  
4 following is substituted in lieu thereof (*Effective from passage*):

5 [On and after January 1, 2002, each] Each birth certificate shall  
6 contain the name of the birth mother, except by the order of a court of  
7 competent jurisdiction. No later than thirty days after the registration  
8 of such birth, a replacement birth certificate shall be issued in  
9 conformity with said order. The original birth certificate, including all  
10 information required on a confidential portion of the certificate,  
11 pursuant to section 7-48, shall remain confidential in the same manner  
12 and to the same extent as provided in section 7-53, as amended."
