"AN ACT CONCERNING FUNERAL DIRECTORS AND VITAL RECORDS."

1 After the last section, add the following and renumber sections and
2 internal references accordingly:

3 "Sec. 501. Section 7-48a of the general statutes is repealed and the
4 following is substituted in lieu thereof (*Effective from passage*):

5 On and after January 1, 2002, each birth certificate shall [contain the
6 name of the birth mother, except by the order of a court of competent
7 jurisdiction] be filed with the name of the birth mother recorded. Not
8 later than forty-five days after receipt of an order from a court of
9 competent jurisdiction, the Department of Public Health shall create a
10 replacement certificate in accordance with the court's order. Such
11 replacement certificate shall include all information required to be
12 included in a certificate of birth of this state as of the date of the birth.

13 When a certified copy of such certificate of birth is requested by an
14 eligible party, as provided in section 7-51, a copy of the replacement
15 certificate shall be provided. The department shall seal the original
16 certificate of birth in accordance with the provisions of subsection (c)
17 of section 19a-42. Immediately after a replacement certificate has been
18 prepared, the department shall transmit an exact copy of such
19 certificate to the registrar of vital statistics of the town of birth and to
20 any other registrar as the department deems appropriate. The town
21 shall proceed in accordance with the provisions of section 19a-42."
