"AN ACT INCREASING THE MINIMUM WAGE."

1 After the last section, add the following and renumber sections and
2 internal references accordingly:

3 "Sec. 501. Section 31-58a of the general statutes is repealed and the
4 following is substituted in lieu thereof (*Effective October 1, 2004*):

5 (a) Notwithstanding the provisions of subsection (j) of section 31-58,
6 as amended by section 1 of this act, minors between the ages of sixteen
7 and eighteen years who are employees of the state or any political
8 subdivision thereof shall be paid a minimum wage of not less than
9 eighty-five per cent of the minimum fair wage as defined in said
10 subsection, and notwithstanding the provisions of said subsection,
11 minors between the ages of fourteen and eighteen who are agricultural
12 employees shall be paid a minimum wage of not less than eighty-five
13 per cent of the minimum fair wage as defined in said section except
14 agricultural employees between the ages of fourteen and eighteen who
15 are employed by employers who did not, during the preceding

16 calendar year, employ eight or more workers at the same time shall be
17 paid a minimum wage of not less than seventy per cent of the
18 minimum wage as defined in said section 31-58.

19 (b) Notwithstanding the provisions of subsection (j) of section 31-58,
20 as amended by section 1 of this act, persons participating in federally-
21 funded job training programs shall not be entitled to an increase in the
22 minimum fair wage, except as may be required under the federal Fair
23 Labor Standards Act."
