**"AN ACT CONCERNING THE MERGER OF THE DEPARTMENT OF CORRECTION AND THE BOARD OF PAROLE AND THE CARRYING OF HANDGUNS BY EMPLOYEES OF THE DEPARTMENT OF CORRECTION."**

1 After the last section, add the following and renumber sections and  
2 internal references accordingly:

3 "Sec. 501. Subsection (a) of section 29-28 of the general statutes is  
4 repealed and the following is substituted in lieu thereof (*Effective*  
5 *October 1, 2004*):

6 (a) No person who sells ten or more pistols or revolvers in a  
7 calendar year or is a federally-licensed firearm dealer shall advertise,  
8 sell, deliver, or offer or expose for sale or delivery, or have in such  
9 person's possession with intent to sell or deliver, any pistol or revolver  
10 at retail without having a permit therefor issued as provided in this  
11 subsection. The chief of police or, where there is no chief of police, the  
12 warden of the borough or the first selectman of the town, as the case

13 may be, may, upon the application of any person, issue a permit in  
14 such form as may be prescribed by the Commissioner of Public Safety  
15 for the sale at retail of pistols and revolvers within the jurisdiction of  
16 the authority issuing such permit or at a gun show, as defined in  
17 section 29-37g, held within the jurisdiction of any local authority in the  
18 state. No permit for the sale at retail of any pistol or revolver issued  
19 pursuant to subsection (b) of this section and the applicant submits  
20 documentation sufficient to establish that local zoning requirements  
21 have been met for the location where the sale is to take place except  
22 that any person selling or exchanging a pistol or revolver for the  
23 enhancement of a personal collection or for a hobby or who sells all or  
24 part of such person's personal collection of pistols or revolvers shall  
25 not be required to submit such documentation for the location where  
26 the sale or exchange is to take place.

27 Sec. 502. Subsection (a) of section 29-30 of the general statutes is  
28 repealed and the following is substituted in lieu thereof (*Effective*  
29 *October 1, 2004*):

30 (a) The fee for each permit originally issued under the provisions of  
31 subsection (a) of section 29-28, as amended by this act, for the sale at  
32 retail of pistols and revolvers shall be one hundred dollars and for  
33 each renewal thereof one hundred dollars, except that the fee for each  
34 permit for such sale at retail at a gun show shall not exceed twenty-five  
35 dollars for each day of such show, provided such permittee at such  
36 show has a fixed location in the state for the sale of pistols and  
37 revolvers at retail. The fee for each state permit originally issued under  
38 the provisions of subsection (b) of section 29-28 for the carrying of  
39 pistols and revolvers shall be seventy dollars plus sufficient funds as  
40 required to be transmitted to the Federal Bureau of Investigation to  
41 cover the cost of a national criminal history records check. The local  
42 authority shall forward sufficient funds for the national criminal  
43 history records check to the commissioner no later than five business  
44 days after receipt by the local authority of the application for the  
45 temporary state permit. Thirty-five dollars shall be retained by the  
46 local authority. Upon approval by the local authority of the application

47 for a temporary state permit, thirty-five dollars shall be sent to the  
48 commissioner. The fee to renew each state permit originally issued  
49 under the provisions of subsection (b) of section 29-28 shall be thirty-  
50 five dollars. Upon deposit of such fees in the General Fund, ten dollars  
51 of each fee shall be credited within thirty days to the appropriation for  
52 the Department of Public Safety to a separate nonlapsing account for  
53 the purposes of the issuance of permits under subsections (a) and (b) of  
54 section 29-28, as amended by this act."
