The Committee on Environment reported through REP. ROY of the 119th Dist., Chairperson of the Committee on the part of the House, that the bill ought to pass.

AN ACT CONCERNING OPEN SPACE AND ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT IN THE CITY OF SHELTON.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 Section 1. (*Effective from passage*) The Commissioner of Economic
2 and Community Development shall revise the Assistance Agreement
3 between the state of Connecticut, acting by the Department of
4 Economic and Community Development, and the Shelton Economic
5 Development Corporation, to provide that (1) the parcel of land
6 identified in Phase I of such agreement is designated for open space
7 purposes, (2) the parcel of land identified in Phase II of such agreement
8 is designated for economic development, and (3) the state and the city
9 of Shelton and their agents and assigns be held harmless with respect
10 to such designations.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:
