The Committee on Judiciary reported through REP. LAWLOR of the 99th Dist., Chairperson of the Committee on the part of the House, that the bill ought to pass.

***AN ACT CONFIRMING AND ADOPTING VOLUMES 1 TO 13, INCLUSIVE, OF THE GENERAL STATUTES, REVISED TO 2005.***

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 Section 1. (NEW) (*Effective from passage*) Volumes 1 to 13, inclusive, of  
2 the general statutes of Connecticut, revised to 1958, consolidated,  
3 codified, arranged and revised to January 1, 2005, by the legislative  
4 commissioners under the provisions of subsection (g) of section 2-56 of  
5 the general statutes and published under the title "The General Statutes  
6 of Connecticut, Revision of 1958, Revised to January 1, 2005", including  
7 the consolidation, codification, arrangement and revision of the public  
8 acts of the state from 1959 through 2004, inclusive, are adopted, ratified,  
9 confirmed and enacted.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:
