## **AN ACT CONCERNING REGISTRARS OF VOTERS.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 Section 1. (*Effective July 1, 2005*) The joint standing committee of the  
2 General Assembly having cognizance of matters relating to elections  
3 shall study the efficiency and effectiveness of registrar of voters  
4 operations and procedures. Not later than January 1, 2006, said  
5 committee shall submit a report to the General Assembly, in  
6 accordance with the provisions of section 11-4a of the general statutes,  
7 on its findings and recommendations.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:
