Explanation

The resolution accepts the recommendation of the Claims Commissioner to deny a claim against the state by Paul Wielk. The resolution thereby results in the avoidance of a potential state cost in excess of \$7,500. Claimant is seeking to be compensated for personal injuries he allegedly sustained when another male student at Platt Regional Vocational-Technical School assaulted him.

Pursuant to CGS Section 4-160, amounts awarded upon contractual claims for goods or services shall be paid from the appropriation of the agency which received such goods or services. All other amounts, including personal injury awards, are paid from the resources of the General Fund via the Adjudicated Claims account.¹

¹ The Adjudicated Claims account is a non-appropriated, General Fund account within the State Comptroller’s agency for administrative purposes. Payments from this account would reduce a surplus or increase a deficit in the General Fund.
