**AN ACT CONCERNING A STUDY OF THE FEASIBILITY OF
ELIMINATING OR EQUALIZING THE PERSONAL PROPERTY TAX ON
MOTOR VEHICLES.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That the Office of Policy and Management shall (1) study the
- 2 feasibility of eliminating the personal property tax on motor vehicles
- 3 or equalizing said tax state wide, (2) study the resulting effect on
- 4 taxpayers in this state, (3) determine any costs or benefits of either such
- 5 action, and (4) report on any findings or recommendations regarding
- 6 the elimination or equalization of said tax.

Statement of Purpose:

To study the feasibility of eliminating the personal property tax on motor vehicles or equalizing said tax state wide.
