***AN ACT ESTABLISHING THE NORTH CENTRAL PROBATE DISTRICT.***

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 That part I of chapter 801 of the general statutes be amended to  
2 provide that the towns of Bloomfield and East Granby shall, on and  
3 after the first Wednesday following the first Monday of January, 2007,  
4 constitute a probate district by the name of the North Central Probate  
5 District; that in 2006, and quadrennially thereafter, a judge of probate  
6 for such district shall be elected at the time and in the manner  
7 provided by law for the election of judges of probate; and that on and  
8 after the first Wednesday following the first Monday of January, 2007,  
9 the North Central Probate District shall have jurisdiction of all probate  
10 business arising in the towns of Bloomfield and East Granby.

***Statement of Purpose:***

To provide cost efficiency and more services for residents of East Granby by merging the probate districts of Bloomfield and East Granby.
