**AN ACT CONCERNING THE DEFENSE OF LIABILITY CLAIMS
AGAINST OWNERS OF LAND MADE AVAILABLE TO THE PUBLIC
FOR RECREATIONAL PURPOSES.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That section 52-557g of the general statutes be amended to provide
- 2 that the Attorney General shall defend an owner of land, who makes
- 3 all or part of such land available to the public without charge, rent, fee
- 4 or other commercial service for recreational purposes, against a claim
- 5 brought by an individual who is injured in the course of using such
- 6 land for recreational purposes.

Statement of Purpose:

To require the Attorney General to defend owners of land made available to the public for recreational purposes without charge against claims brought by individuals who are injured in the course of using such land for recreational purposes.
