AN ACT CONCERNING THE ISSUANCE OF PERMITS FOR THE USE OF FLASHING LIGHTS AND SIRENS ON EMERGENCY MEDICAL VEHICLES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 Section 1. (NEW) (*Effective October 1, 2005*) (a) Any permit issued by
2 the Commissioner of Motor Vehicles for the use of flashing lights by an
3 ambulance or other emergency medical vehicle, as provided in section
4 14-96p or 14-96q of the general statutes, shall be issued at the same
5 time as the motor vehicle registration certificate for such vehicle under
6 part III(A) of chapter 246 of the general statutes or section 19a-181 of
7 the general statutes.

8 (b) Any approval issued by the commissioner for a siren to be used
9 by an ambulance or other emergency medical vehicle, as provided in
10 subsection (f) of section 14-80 of the general statutes, shall be issued at
11 the same time as the motor vehicle registration certificate for such
12 vehicle under part III(A) of chapter 246 of the general statutes or
13 section 19a-181 of the general statutes.
