AN ACT PROMOTING THE SAFE OPERATION OF ALL-TERRAIN VEHICLES BY MINORS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That chapter 447 of the general statutes be amended to require that
- 2 any person under the age of eighteen years who operates an all-terrain
- 3 vehicle or is a passenger on an all-terrain vehicle on state land shall
- 4 wear protective headgear and that any application of a person between
- 5 twelve and sixteen years of age to take a safety education course for
- 6 all-terrain vehicles contain the signature of a parent or guardian of
- 7 such person.

Statement of Purpose:

To require that minors who operate or are passengers on all-terrain vehicles wear protective headgear and to require parental signature before a minor between twelve and sixteen years of age may take a safety education course for all-terrain vehicles.
