**AN ACT REVOKING THE PENSION OF CERTAIN STATE OR MUNICIPAL PUBLIC OFFICIALS OR EMPLOYEES WHO ARE CONVICTED OF FELONIES.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That the general statutes be amended to prohibit a state or
- 2 municipal public official or employee who is convicted of a felony that
- 3 involves the misuse of such official's or employee's office or position
- 4 from receiving any pension earned during such service as an elected
- 5 official or employee.

**Statement of Purpose:**

To prohibit state and municipal public officials and employees who are convicted of job-related felonies from collecting pensions for such service.
