**AN ACT REQUIRING PERSONS WHO APPLY FOR TOWN HAWKING  
AND VENDING LICENSES TO SUBMIT TO STATE AND NATIONAL  
CRIMINAL BACKGROUND CHECKS.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General  
Assembly convened:

- 1 That section 21-37 of the general statutes be amended to require
- 2 persons submitting an application for a hawking or vending license to
- 3 submit to state and national criminal background checks and enable a
- 4 town to deny an applicant such license if such background check
- 5 indicates a history of criminal activity provided minors who are selling
- 6 goods as part of a fundraising campaign by a nonprofit organization
- 7 are exempted from such background checks.

**Statement of Purpose:**

To enable towns to conduct criminal background checks on persons  
applying for vending licenses.
