**AN ACT CONCERNING A COMMITTEE TO STUDY FINES FOR  
MOTOR VEHICLE VIOLATIONS.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 Section 1. (NEW) (*Effective July 1, 2005*) The joint standing committee  
2 of the General Assembly having cognizance of matters relating to  
3 transportation shall study whether to raise the fines for moving  
4 violations that result in accidents, reduce the fines for moving  
5 violations that do not result in accidents, reduce the fine for  
6 nonmoving violations and raise the fine for exceeding the speed limit  
7 in a school zone. Said joint standing committee shall report its findings  
8 and recommendations to the General Assembly on or before January 1,  
9 2006, in accordance with section 11-4a of the general statutes.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:
