AN ACT ESTABLISHING A SCHOOL TECHNOLOGY GRANT PROGRAM.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 That the general statutes be amended to provide for the
2 establishment of a school technology grant program which will
3 provide a grant of two hundred dollars per student for each student in
4 a school district in grades six through twelve, inclusive, and to require
5 that the grant funds be used for teaching science and engineering and
6 for purchase of appropriate technology to support science and
7 engineering programs. Such grants shall also be available to
8 vocational-technical and magnet schools.

Statement of Purpose:

To provide funding to school districts for technology, science and engineering programs for students in grades six through twelve, inclusive.
