**AN ACT PROHIBITING THE REQUIREMENT THAT PRESCRIPTIONS
BE FILLED BY MAIL ORDER.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That chapter 700c of the general statutes be amended to prohibit any
- 2 employer, health insurer or health care center that provides health
- 3 insurance or health benefits in this state from requiring insureds,
- 4 employees or beneficiaries to fill prescription orders by mail.

Statement of Purpose:

To prohibit employers and insurers from requiring insureds to fill prescriptions through the mail.
