AN ACT CONCERNING THE REQUIREMENT THAT PRESCRIPTIONS BE FILLED BY MAIL ORDER.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 Section 1. (NEW) (*Effective July 1, 2005*) (a) No health insurance
2 policy issued on an individual basis, whether issued by an insurance
3 company, a hospital service corporation, a medical service corporation
4 or a health care center, which provides coverage for prescription drugs
5 may require any person covered under such policy to obtain
6 prescription drugs from a mail order pharmacy as a condition of
7 obtaining benefits for such drugs.
- 8 (b) The provisions of this section shall apply to any such policy
9 delivered, issued for delivery, renewed, amended or continued in this
10 state on or after July 1, 2005.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:
