**AN ACT CONCERNING IN-STATE TUITION AND THE "A BETTER
CHANCE" PROGRAM.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General
Assembly convened:

- 1 That section 10a-29 of the general statutes be amended to allow an
- 2 unemancipated student who participates in the "A Better Chance"
- 3 program, who graduates from a high school in Connecticut, and who
- 4 resides in this state for four years or more to be entitled to
- 5 classification as an in-state student.

Statement of Purpose:

To allow students from "A Better Chance" who graduate from
Connecticut high schools and who have resided in this state for four or
more years to be considered in-state students for tuition purposes at
state institutions of higher education.
