**AN ACT CONCERNING A RETAIL SKILL CENTER PILOT PROGRAM
IN MILFORD.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 Section 1. (*Effective from passage*) On or before January 1, 2006, the
2 Labor Commissioner shall, in cooperation with shopping mall
3 operators, retail employers, appropriate federal, state and local
4 governmental entities, schools and colleges, retail trade associations
5 and other community organizations, establish a retail skill center pilot
6 program at a retail shopping center in Milford to recruit, train and
7 motivate individuals for jobs and careers in the retail industry and to
8 place individuals completing such program into long-term retail and
9 related jobs. On or before January 1, 2007, the Labor Commissioner
10 shall report, in accordance with the provisions of section 11-4a of the
11 general statutes, on the results of the pilot program to the joint
12 standing committee of the General Assembly having cognizance of
13 matters relating to labor.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:
