AN ACT CONCERNING THE WITHDRAWAL OF A STUDENT FROM SCHOOL BY A PARENT.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That section 10-184 of the general statutes be amended to provide
- 2 that whenever a parent or legal guardian of a child provides notice, by
- 3 any means, to staff, administrators, or those in charge of a school that
- 4 the parent or legal guardian is withdrawing a child from enrollment in
- 5 a school, such notice shall be accepted and the child shall be deemed
- 6 withdrawn from enrollment upon such notification.

Statement of Purpose:

To clarify the authority of parents to withdraw a child from enrollment in school.
