AN ACT CONCERNING OPEN SPACE AND ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT IN THE CITY OF SHELTON.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 That the general statutes be amended to redesignate for open space
2 purposes the parcel of land identified in Phase I of the Assistance
3 Agreement by and between the state of Connecticut acting by the
4 Department of Economic and Community Development and the
5 Shelton Economic Development Corporation, initially designated for
6 economic development purposes pursuant to chapter 132 of the
7 general statutes, that the city and the Shelton Economic Development
8 Corporation revise said agreement to designate the parcel of land
9 identified in Phase II of said agreement for economic development
10 purposes and that the state of Connecticut and the city of Shelton, their
11 agents and assigns be held harmless with respect to such actions.

Statement of Purpose:

To require the city of Shelton to designate more land as open space and to designate an alternate parcel for economic development purposes.
