**AN ACT CONCERNING MUNICIPAL TAKING OF FARM LAND BY
EMINENT DOMAIN.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That section 7-131o of the general statutes be amended to exempt
- 2 from the provisions of said section the taking by a municipality by
- 3 eminent domain of active agricultural land if the land remains active
- 4 agricultural land under the ownership of the municipality.

Statement of Purpose:

To provide that a municipality that takes farm land by eminent domain does not have to purchase an equivalent amount of farm land if the land originally taken will remain active agricultural land.
