**AN ACT CONCERNING THE REGISTRATION OF ALL-TERRAIN
VEHICLES AND THE ESTABLISHMENT OF AN ALL-TERRAIN
VEHICLE ACCOUNT.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General
Assembly convened:

- 1 That the general statutes be amended to require the registration of
- 2 all-terrain vehicles before they may be insured or operated on any land
- 3 in the state and to establish an account, within the Conservation Fund,
- 4 to be known as the all-terrain vehicle account to fund programs,
- 5 facilities and certain expenses related to all-terrain vehicles.

Statement of Purpose:

To require that all-terrain vehicles be registered before they may be
insured or operated on any land in the state and to use revenues from
such registration to establish an all-terrain vehicle account to fund
programs, facilities and certain expenses related to all-terrain vehicles.
