**AN ACT CONCERNING PERSONAL SERVICE AGREEMENTS.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 Section 1. Section 4a-7a of the general statutes is repealed and the  
2 following is substituted in lieu thereof (*Effective October 1, 2005*):

3 (a) As used in this section, "personal service agreement" means a  
4 written agreement between the state and an individual for services  
5 rendered to the state which are infrequent or unique.

6 (b) A personal service agreement between a state agency and an  
7 individual shall have a term of not more than one year. Any such  
8 personal service agreement may be extended or renewed, for an  
9 unlimited term [, provided] if the state extends the appropriate  
10 collective bargaining benefits to the individual and the appropriate  
11 collective bargaining representative, the Commissioner of  
12 Administrative Services and the joint standing committee of the  
13 General Assembly having cognizance of matters relating to labor and  
14 public employees are notified of such extension or renewal.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:
