AN ACT CONCERNING A STUDY OF MUNICIPAL EMPLOYEE AND TEACHER BINDING ARBITRATION.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That the legislative program review and investigations committee
- 2 do a study of municipal employee binding arbitration under section 7-
- 3 473c of the general statutes and teacher binding arbitration under
- 4 section 10-153f of the general statutes.

Statement of Purpose:

To provide information on the impact of all facets of binding arbitration, including stipulated agreements, on the fiscal condition of towns.
