**AN ACT CONCERNING THE TIMEFRAME FOR SUBMISSION OF APPLICATIONS TO INLAND WETLANDS AGENCIES.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That subdivision (1) of subsection (c) of section 22a-42a of the
- 2 general statutes be amended to require that the date of receipt of an
- 3 application to conduct a regulated activity upon an inland wetland or
- 4 watercourse shall be the day of the next regularly scheduled meeting
- 5 of such inland wetlands agency, immediately following the day of
- 6 submission to such inland wetland agency or its agent of such
- 7 application, provided such meeting is no earlier than three business
- 8 days after receipt.

**Statement of Purpose:**

To revise the statutory timeframe concerning the number of days that an application can be submitted for consideration before an inland wetlands agency from one day to three days.
