AN ACT CONCERNING AN INCOME TAX CREDIT FOR NONMEDICAL COSTS INCURRED BY ORGAN DONORS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That chapter 229 of the general statutes be amended to provide a
- 2 credit against the income tax liability for taxpayers donating a kidney,
- 3 pancreas, intestine, lung or bone marrow. Such credit shall be up to ten
- 4 thousand dollars for nonmedical costs incurred in the donation
- 5 process.

Statement of Purpose:

To provide a tax break for organ donors based on nonmedical costs incurred in the donation process.
