AN ACT CONCERNING A REDUCTION IN THE DRY CLEANING TAX FOR ESTABLISHMENTS USING ENVIRONMENTALLY-FRIENDLY PROCESSES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That chapter 211b of the general statutes be amended to reduce the
- 2 surcharge on dry cleaning establishments using environmentally-
- 3 friendly processes, as determined by the Department of Environmental
- 4 Protection, from one per cent to one-half of one per cent of gross
- 5 receipts at retail.

Statement of Purpose:

To encourage the development of environmentally-friendly dry cleaning products and establishments by reducing the dry cleaning surcharge for environmentally-friendly dry cleaning businesses in half, to one-half of one per cent of gross receipts at retail.
