**AN ACT CONCERNING TAXATION OF OUT-OF-STATE RESIDENTS'
CASINO WINNINGS.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That the general statutes be amended to require that out-of-state
- 2 residents pay income tax to Connecticut on any money won at a casino
- 3 in this state.

Statement of Purpose:

To generate revenue for Connecticut and bring equity to Connecticut taxpayers.
