AN ACT NAMING A PORTION OF ROUTE 618 THE "MAJOR PETER M. CLEARY MEMORIAL HIGHWAY".

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That the section of Route 618 from Route 85 to the Lebanon town
- 2 line be named the "Major Peter M. Cleary Memorial Highway".

Statement of Purpose:

To honor the memory and sacrifice of Air Force Major Peter M. Cleary of Colchester, CT. whose plane was shot down during the Vietnam War. Major Cleary was listed as MIA until last year when his remains were discovered and returned to the United States for a proper military burial in Arlington National Cemetery.
