**AN ACT PROHIBITING CERTAIN LIQUOR ADVERTISEMENTS ON
THE EXTERIOR OF LIQUOR PERMIT PREMISES.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That section 30-95 of the general statutes be amended to prohibit the
- 2 owner of a liquor permit premises to display upon the exterior of such
- 3 premises a sign painted in luminous or reflective paint that advertises
- 4 the sale of any registered brand of alcoholic liquor.

Statement of Purpose:

To prohibit certain liquor advertisements.
