**AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE RETAIL SALE OF BEER BY PERSONS WHO HOLD A MANUFACTURER PERMIT FOR BEER OR A BREW PUB.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That section 30-16 of the general statutes be amended to authorize
- 2 the retail sale of beer for consumption off the premises by persons who
- 3 hold a manufacturer permit for beer or a manufacturer permit for a
- 4 brew pub.

**Statement of Purpose:**

To increase tourism in Connecticut by allowing individuals touring brew pubs to purchase beer for off-site consumption.
