AN ACT REQUIRING FURNITURE DEALERS WHO ARE GOING OUT OF BUSINESS TO PROVIDE NOTICE TO CERTAIN CUSTOMERS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That the general statutes be amended to require furniture dealers
- 2 who are going out of business to provide written notice of such
- 3 imminent closure to customers who have paid a deposit on any item of
- 4 furniture that has not yet been delivered. Such notice shall include
- 5 procedures the customer needs to follow in order to recover any funds
- 6 paid toward the purchase of such furniture.

Statement of Purpose:

To protect consumers when a furniture store goes out of business.
