**AN ACT REQUIRING THE FILING OF AFFIRMATIVE ACTION PLANS
BY ALL BRANCHES OF STATE GOVERNMENT.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That the general statutes be amended to require the filing of
- 2 affirmative action plans every two years by the executive, legislative
- 3 and judicial branches of state government.

Statement of Purpose:

To monitor hiring practices in state government and encourage a diverse staff.
