**AN ACT CONCERNING ELIGIBILITY FOR ASSISTANCE, GRANTS
AND LOANS FOR THE BEVERLY HILLS SECTION OF NEW HAVEN.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General
Assembly convened:

- 1 Section 1. (NEW) (*Effective from passage*) Notwithstanding the
2 provisions of the general statutes or any special act, owners of real
3 property located in the Beverly Hills section of New Haven and such
4 real property shall be deemed eligible for state financial assistance
5 from any fund established for the New Haven community as a result
6 of any conversion of a bank from a mutual savings bank to a stock
7 bank for the purpose of mitigating damage to the foundations of
8 dwellings located in said Beverly Hills section due to the siting of such
9 dwellings in the immediate vicinity of the West River.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following
sections:

To help home owners in the Beverly Hills section of New Haven by the
provision of assistance, grants and loans to mitigate damage to the

foundations of residences within such section due to siting of such residences in the immediate vicinity of the West River.
