**AN ACT CONCERNING APPROPRIATIONS TO THE DEPARTMENT  
OF SOCIAL SERVICES FOR ADULT TRAINING OPPORTUNITIES.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That the sum of fifty thousand dollars be appropriated to the
- 2 Department of Social Services, from the General Fund, for the fiscal
- 3 year ending June 30, 2006, for the Human Resources Development -
- 4 Hispanic Programs account in order to permit the Rivera-Hughes
- 5 Memorial Foundation in Waterbury to purchase computers and offer
- 6 vocational computer training opportunities to adults.
