AN ACT CONCERNING APPROPRIATIONS TO THE DEPARTMENT OF SOCIAL SERVICES FOR ADULT TRAINING OPPORTUNITIES IN WATERBURY.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 Section 1. (*Effective July 1, 2005*) The sum of fifty thousand dollars is
2 appropriated to the Department of Social Services, from the General
3 Fund, for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2006, for the Human
4 Resources Development - Hispanic Programs account in order to
5 permit a community agency in Waterbury to purchase computers and
6 offer vocational computer training opportunities to adults.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:
