**AN ACT CONCERNING STATE CLAIMS AGAINST CAUSE OF ACTION PROCEEDS RECEIVED BY PUBLIC ASSISTANCE BENEFICIARIES.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 That section 17b-94 of the general statutes be amended to provide  
2 that any insurance company, doing business in the state, prior to  
3 disbursing proceeds in excess of ten thousand dollars that resolve a  
4 cause of action that is not the subject of a judicial proceeding, shall  
5 provide the Commissioner of Administrative Services with the name  
6 of the individual who is to receive the proceeds, and any other  
7 information that the commissioner may require, to allow the  
8 Commissioner of Administrative Services to make a determination as  
9 to whether such proceeds are subject to claim by the state.

**Statement of Purpose:**

To increase revenue to the state by enhancing the Department of Administrative Services ability to make claims against cause of action proceeds.
