AN ACT CONCERNING THE ESTABLISHMENT OF THE EASTERN CONNECTICUT IMMIGRANT RESOURCE CENTER.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That the sum of ____ dollars be appropriated to the Department of
- 2 Social Services, from the General Fund, for the fiscal year ending June
- 3 30, 2006, for the establishment and funding of the Eastern Connecticut
- 4 Immigrant Resource Center.

Statement of Purpose:
