**AN ACT AUTHORIZING BONDS OF THE STATE FOR RENOVATIONS
TO THE ROSS ADULT DAY CARE CENTER IN NORWICH.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That the State Bond Commission be empowered to authorize the
- 2 issuance of bonds of the state in accordance with section 3-20 of the
- 3 general statutes, in principal amounts not exceeding in the aggregate
- 4 three hundred fifty-seven thousand dollars, the proceeds of which
- 5 shall be used by the Department of Social Services for the purpose of
- 6 funding renovations to the Ross adult day care center in Norwich.

Statement of Purpose:

To better serve the elderly population of southeastern Connecticut by providing funds to the Ross adult day care center in Norwich to permit an expansion of the facility in order to address the increased need for adult day care services.
