**AN ACT CONCERNING EXPANSION OF THE KATIE BECKETT
WAIVER.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That the sum of two million dollars be appropriated to the
- 2 Department of Social Services, from the General Fund, for the fiscal
- 3 year ending June 30, 2006, for the purpose of expanding the number of
- 4 funded slots for participation in the Katie Beckett Model Home and
- 5 Community Waiver from one hundred twenty-five to two hundred.

Statement of Purpose:

To reduce the waiting list for Katie Beckett waiver slots by increasing the number of funded slots from one hundred twenty-five to two hundred.
