**AN ACT CONCERNING APPROPRIATIONS TO THE DEPARTMENT OF SOCIAL SERVICES FOR NUTRITIONAL AND CULTURAL PROGRAMS FOR ELDERLY LATINO IN WATERBURY.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 Section 1. (*Effective July 1, 2005*) The sum of five thousand dollars is  
2 appropriated to the Department of Social Services, from the General  
3 Fund, for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2006, for the Services to the  
4 Elderly account in order to increase funding to a community agency in  
5 Waterbury that provides nutritional and cultural programs to the  
6 area's elderly Latino population.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:
