**AN ACT CONCERNING RESTORATION OF HUSKY A BENEFITS FOR PARENTS AND NEEDY CARETAKER RELATIVES.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That subsection (a) of section 17b-261 of the general statutes be
- 2 amended to provide that parents and needy caretaker relatives with
- 3 family income up to one hundred fifty per cent of the federal poverty
- 4 level shall be eligible for medical assistance program benefits.

**Statement of Purpose:**

To restore HUSKY A medical benefits to parents and needy caretaker relatives with income that does not exceed one hundred fifty per cent of the federal poverty level.
