AN ACT CONCERNING RENEWAL OF LAPSED PARAMEDIC LICENSES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That chapter 384d of the general statutes be amended to allow the
- 2 Commissioner of Public Health to renew a paramedic license for any
- 3 applicant whose paramedic license has lapsed without requiring the
- 4 applicant to successfully pass the examination prescribed by the
- 5 commissioner, provided the applicant successfully completes an
- 6 emergency medical technician refresher training course that not later
- 7 than one year from the date the license lapsed.

Statement of Purpose:

To allow for the renewal of lapsed paramedic licenses without examination under certain circumstances.
