**AN ACT REQUIRING THE ESTABLISHMENT OF A STATE-WIDE  
DATABASE FOR USE BY POLICE OFFICERS.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That a state-wide database be established for use by police officers
- 2 that shall include, but not be limited to, criminal history and firearm
- 3 registration information. Such information may be accessed by such
- 4 officers from their police vehicles prior to or during any summons to a
- 5 residence.

**Statement of Purpose:**

To enable police officers to have complete information about residences they are summoned to for their safety.
