AN ACT CONCERNING THE USE OF FLASHING OR REVOLVING LIGHTS BY VOLUNTEER FIRE CHIEFS AND THEIR DEPUTIES AND ASSISTANTS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That subdivision (4) of subsection (a) of section 14-96p of the general
- 2 statutes be amended to allow a total of six volunteer fire chiefs and
- 3 their deputies and assistants per municipality to use flashing or
- 4 revolving white lights in combination with flashing or revolving red
- 5 lights on their motor vehicles, in lieu of a total of four per municipality,
- 6 in the event there are no paid fire chiefs, deputies and assistants and
- 7 there is more than one volunteer fire department.

Statement of Purpose:

To expand the number of volunteer fire chiefs and their deputies and assistants who may use flashing or revolving white lights in combination with flashing or revolving red lights on their motor vehicles.
