AN ACT CONCERNING RETIREMENT CREDIT FOR CERTAIN ACTIVE DUTY MILITARY SERVICE FOR TRAINING PURPOSES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That the general statutes be amended to provide that any individual
- 2 who was on active duty military service for training purposes between
- 3 September 1, 1968, and January 31, 1969, shall receive retirement credit
- 4 for such service in Tier II of the state employees retirement system.

Statement of Purpose:

To allow military personnel on active duty for training purposes during certain times of war to obtain retirement credit in SERS for such period in training.
